Dr. V.D.Patil, Registrar and Member-Secretary welcomed the members.

Hon. Vice-Chancellor briefed the members with the following information:

- The meetings of various Boards of Studies are being convened twice in a year. In view of the meaningful outcomes of the meeting of various BoS and statutory bodies of the University, it is suggested that that all the members including external members to actively participate and deliberate on important academic matters including revision in the course curriculum, examination reforms, scheme of examination, etc. so as to bring out timely and effective changes in curriculum, exam scheme of marking, etc.. They must also ensure that the norms of the respective Regulating Councils are strictly adhered to.
- The respective Deans / Chairpersons of the BoS should ensure that the documents pertaining to the respective BoS meetings like Meeting Notice, ATR, Agenda, etc. are maintained in their respective departments / institutions.
- Based on the deliberations / recommendations of the BoS, the respective Deans / Chairpersons shall generate agenda pertaining to various academic activities (UG, PG and Research) which is required to be placed in the meetings of the Academic Council / BPGT&R, RRC and RGC for further consideration.
- Each agenda item put forth in the Academic Council should be specific with the details like need for change, council guidelines and the actual proposal for consideration.
- The presentation should be well-focused substantiating / justifying the resolutions adopted in the BoS meetings. While preparing and presenting the minutes, separate items to be prepared like Agenda for ratification, Agenda for information and Agenda for consideration. The follow up action initiated on each of the resolutions be prepared and attached in the form of Action Taken Report along-with the Agenda of the Academic Council / BPGT&R, RRC and RGC of the University.
- The Director, Academic Affairs shall co-ordinate in this regard.
- The feed-back and suggestions from the stakeholders / faculty members / students as regards to teaching-learning process, examination reforms, etc. should be discussed in the BoS and other forums and the same need to be analyzed and explored for implementation.

RESOLUTIONS ADOPTED IN THE MEETING OF THE ACADEMIC COUNCIL HELD ON 15-11-2017 BASED ON THE RECOMMENDATIONS OF THE BOARDS OF STUDIES

1. Consideration of starting of Intensive Course in Epidemiology and Biostatistics:

The Academic Council considered and approved starting of Intensive Course in Epidemiology and Biostatistics with course duration of 15 days from the academic year 2018-19.

2. Consideration of increase in the practical / clinical marks for Post-Graduate and Super-specialty Degree and Diploma medical courses:

The Academic Council considered and approved the revision of total marks in practical / clinical exam for all the Post-Graduate and Super-specialty Degree and Diploma medical courses (excluding allied PG courses) from the present 300 to 400 marks for MD / MS and Super-Specialty courses and from 200 to 300 marks for the Diploma courses. The aforesaid scheme wil be effective from June / July 2018. The split of the marks in the respective subjects will be submitted by the Dean.

3. Consideration of posting of Post-Graduate students to Hi-tech Laboratory:

The Academic Council considered and approved posting of Post-Graduate (Microbiology / Biochemistry / Pathology) students to Hi-tech Laboratory of KLES Dr. Prabhakar Kore Hospital and Medical Research Centre, Belagavi mainly to enhance their practical skills in the respective subjects.

4. Consideration of inclusion of hands-on skill development in the curriculum of Under-Graduate and Post-Graduate medical courses:

The matter was discussed and the Dean, Faculty of Medicine is requested to submit the details of the skill based programs to be included in the curriculum to revise and submit.

5. Consideration of revision in the course duration of B.Sc. (Allied Courses) from 3 ½ years to 3 years including 6 months of professional training:

The Academic Council considered and approved revision in the course duration of B.Sc. (Allied Courses) from 3 ½ years to 3 years (six semesters) including 6 months of professional training (semester 6). The same shall be applicable to the students admitted from the academic year 2017-18 and to be included in the course curriculum accordingly.

6. Consideration of inclusion of Health Behaviour and Sociology as core subjects for MPH course:

The Academic Council considered and approved inclusion of Health Behaviour and Sociology as core subjects instead of elective subjects for MPH course mainly to enhance the knowledge of health behaviour and sociology. The same is to be included in the course curriculum of MPH accordingly.

7. Consideration of inclusion of topics in Pharmacognosy and Phytochemistry in Pharm D course:

The Academic Council noted that as per the guidelines of the Pharmacy Council of India and as a part of course curriculum of Pharm D course, it has been made mandatory to include the following in the subjects of Pharmacognosy and Phytochemistry:

- a) Carbohydrate derived and biological source
- b) Chemical constituents
- c) Tests, uses and adulterants of following drugs:
 - Honey, Acacia, Agar
 - Sterculia, Tragacanth
 - Cellulose and its products
 - Pectin, Guar gum
 - Sodium Alginate, Linseed
 - Starch

The aforesaid course is being offered in three Pharmacy constituent colleges of the University and in order to maintain uniformity in the aforesaid three constituent pharmacy colleges, the Academic Council resolved to include the aforesaid topics / drugs in the course curriculum of Pharm D which will be applicable to the students admitted from the academic year 2017-18.

8. Consideration of incorporation of case-based learning in practical classes for BDS course:

The Academic Council considered and approved incorporation of case-based learning with case scenarios in practical classes for the students admitted for BDS course from the academic year 2017-18 mainly to enhance the practical skills. The same is to be included in the course curriculum accordingly.

9. Consideration of implementation of the innovative teaching-learning method for I BDS students as 'Early Clinical Exposure':

The Academic Council considered and approved implementation of innovative teaching-learning method for I BDS students as 'Early Clinical Exposure' in the form of visit to PHC and Dental Satellite Centres, Visit to villages for survey and observation of oral health mainly to enhance the clinical skills of these students. The same is to be included in the course curriculum accordingly.

10. Consideration of implementation of 'Carry-Over' system for B.Sc. / PB B.SC. Nursing courses:

The Academic Council considered and approved implementation of 'Carry-Over' system for the students of B.Sc. / PB B.Sc. Nursing courses, keeping in view the norms of the Indian Nursing Council, as detailed below:

- a) A candidate shall be promoted to the next year if he / she failed in one or more subjects.
- b) A candidate shall pass all the papers of the previous examination before appearing for the fourth year examinations.

11. Consideration of starting of Fellowship Program in Ayurcardiology and approval of the course curriculum of the same:

The Academic Council considered and approved starting of Fellowship Program in Ayurcardiology and approval of the course curriculum of the same to be implemented from the academic year 2017-18.

12. Consideration of inclusion of Choice-based credit courses in 1st Prof. BAMS course curriculum:

The Academic Council considered and approved inclusion of Choice-based credit courses in 1st Prof. BAMS course as detailed below which will be applicable from the academic year 2017-18 mainly to develop additional skills:

- a) Prakruti Credential Course (Department of Kriya Sharira)
- b) Samhita Adhyayana Krama (Vadatu Samsktruta) (Department of Basic Principles)
- c) Museum Techniques (Department of Rachana Sharira)

The same is to be included in the course curriculum of the BAMS course accordingly.

13. Consideration of establishment of Cadaveric Lab in the Department of anatomy, J.N.Medical College, Belagavi.

The Academic Council considered and approved the proposal for establishment of Cadaveric Lab in the Department of Anatomy, J.N.Medical College, Belagavi mainly to orient to use fresh cadavers to mimic OT like situation to train post-graduate and under-graduates for advanced surgical skills.

14. Consideration of inclusion of thesis for the Post-Graduate students of Super-specialty Courses (DM / M.Ch) courses.

The Academic Council considered the proposal for inclusion of thesis for the Post-Graduate students of Super-specialty (DM / M.Ch) courses mainly to orient the students to the field of research and publications. The Dean, Faculty of Medicine informed that there is no consensus and no unanimous recommendation from the concerned Heads of the Departments of BoS of Super-specialty courses for inclusion of thesis as a part of the course curriculum.

The Academic Council suggested that the Dean, Faculty of Medicine shall convene a meeting of all the Heads of the Departments of Super-specialty courses / subjects, deliberate upon the matter and submit recommendations to the University for taking appropriate decision in this regard.
