Synonym	golden trumpet, yellow allamanda
Family	Apocynaceae
Distribution	Brazil, French Guyana, Guyana, Suriname, and Venezuela, India
Chemical constituents	hydrocarbons, alcohols, esters, ethers, aldehydes, ketones, fatty acids, phospholipids, volatile compounds, phenolic compounds, flavonoids, alkaloids
Plant part used	bark and leaves
Uses	to treat liver tumors, jaundice, splenomegaly, and malaria
