<p>Family</p>	<p><i>Fabaceae</i></p>
<p>Distribution</p>	<p>Pakistan, India, Bangladesh, Nepal, Sri Lanka, Myanmar, Thailand, Laos, Cambodia, Vietnam, Malaysia, and western Indonesia</p>
<p>Chemical constituents</p>	<p>roteolytic and lypolytic enzymes, plant proteinase and polypeptidase, a nitrogenous acidic compound, along with palasonin.</p>
<p>Plant part used</p>	<p>flowers, bark, leaf and seed gum</p>
<p>Uses</p>	<p>anti-diarrheal, anthelmintic, anti-diabetic, anti-stress, hepatoprotective, antifungal, astringent, aphrodisiac, laxative, anti-inflammatory and antioxidant qualities.</p>
