<b>Botanical name</b>	Caesalpinia pulcherrima (Linn.) Swartz
<b>Family</b>	<i>Caesalpinaeae</i>
<b>Chemical constituents</b>	Flavonoids, Bonducillin, tannins, glycoloids, phenols, steroids, diterpenoids, triterpenoids
<b>Plant parts used</b>	Bark, flower, root, Fruits, Leaves, Seeds, Stem
<b>Uses</b>	Stimulant, Emmenagogue in cholera, abortifacient, cathartic
